ON THE QUALITY OF THE MATERIAL...

It is excellent. It is very well-thought-out. It's geared toward teaching one to think the way Frank Spear and his cohorts do. That doesn't mean that it mandates that we all have to think similarly; the material guides us to come up with solutions to a problem based on a logical sequence of analyzing the clinical parameters. In that way, each component is a very satisfying exercise in thinking and learning.

ON GETTING STARTED...

It's almost too easy. It's all given to you in one complete easy-to-implement package, along with all the support you need, at the beginning at any point thereafter. Now, several years in, I find it requires minimal effort to continue to execute the study club meetings. At this point, the enthusiasm of the members really helps perpetuate the success. Their ongoing desire to have these meetings keeps the momentum going.

HOW IT'S AFFECTING THE RELATIONSHIPS WITH GPS...

The communication is more fluid. The understanding of complex issues is now a mutual understanding rather than a case of having the specialist explain the scenario. An interesting result is that now I see more referring doctors take ownership of a case and guide it and identify an ideal care protocol themselves, rather than just turn it over to me and say, "figure it out for me." They have much more confidence in their ability to treat complex cases. So more patients are arriving with the right mindset, I get the right records and briefings, and that helps us all get the right case acceptance and the right outcome for the patient.

THE IMPACT ON REFERRALS...

There is a degree of loyalty to me now that is unprecedented. I can't put a number on exactly how much the study club has affected my referrals but I can say that my practice, which was great before, is at a whole new level today since I've started hosting this study club.

THE VALUE OF GETTING AWAY TOGETHER...

We have gone to three Spear seminars in Scottsdale together as a group and each time it has been an incredible experience. The format of the presentation is not just good, it's excellent. It's clear, it's concise, and it's organized. These are all-day courses, but every part of it is compelling so nobody gets bored. I remember looking around at the other members of my study club, and they were all completely enthralled by what they are learning. The venue is ideal, too professional and comfortable. It's just a perfect environment for continuing education.
